Nationally, teenage prescription drug abuse is rapidly increasing. Your family MEDICINE CHEST and/or the medicine chests of seniors could become a teenager's best supplier.

Help protect the environment from overdosing on improperly disposed of medications. Collection programs greatly lessen the chance of prescription medications entering the water supply or the food we eat.

### **This Is A Completely Private & Confidential Program!**

No personal information will be asked! Participants may remove prescription labels before arriving. Medications will be collected between **10:00 AM to 2:00 PM** and held only by law enforcement officers until they can be disposed of safely.



Representatives from the Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Department will be on hand to collect medications in lock boxes and drums to properly dispose.
